Installation

Bestop Rear Fender Flares can not be installed with factory wheel well liners. They can be installed without wheel well liners or Bestop Wheel Well Liners Part Number 4966301. If you will be installing Bestop Wheel Well Liners please proceed with 4966301 installation instructions.



Now remove the inner splash shield brace. There are two bolts at the bumper and two bolts at the frame to remove.

Remove these four

bolts on each side


Step 1

If equipt, remove the lower rear splash shield. It requires removing the three M8 bolts.

Remove the plastic shield from the bumper. It also has three M8 bolts attaching it..



Panel Removal Tool



To remove rear; start by releasing the inner fender liner retainers. Use a Panel tool to pry all the plastic trees that join the liner to the Jeep body.

It may be easier to cut the head of the retainer off with snips and remove. You will not reuse any of these fasteners...





With the inner liner fasteners removed and loose, now you can remove the entire fender. Grab the fender and pull the fender away from the body. It's attached with clips. When pulling it away the clips will probably break. Do not be concerned, you're not reusing them.

Start pulling from one corner and work your way to the other side of the fender.


With the OE fender and liner removed clean the body of the Jeep in this area. This is an opportunity for rust prevention or mediation. Section 2 Prep for Flare install Page 5

Continue with rear fender flare installation w/wo Bestop Rear Wheel Liners.





Continue with the Bestop Rear Fender Flare install sheet, from here on, unless you are not installing any Bestop Wheel Well Liners.




Mask off the body with tape while you are prepping holes. Make sure you protect the hole with properly applied and dried touch-up paint, and Bestop recommends RTV as well.

STEP 1: (Bestop Recommended) Place the rear wheel flares to the wheel well and line up with the two holes so that you can temporarily insert bolts and nuts in place as a template, Make sure that all holes are centered, then tighten. Use 10mm (3/8") drill to drill the nutsert hole using the flare flange as a drill-guide. Remove and prep holes, install nutserts and reinstall




Tools



Mask off the body while you are prepping holes. Place the rear wheel flares to the wheel well and line up with the three holes (show HEX above left), so that you can temporarily insert bolts and nuts to tighten in place as a template, Make sure you press or lift up the flare as you center all the holes in flare with the holes in the body. Then snug up the flare to the body. Use the 10mm (25/64") drill bit to make the additional 9th hole using the flare flange as a drill-guide.

Remove Fender again, and prep holes to make sure you protect the exposed metal with properly applied and dried touchup paint, and Bestop recommends RTV as well., install nutserts and reinstall Proceed to Section 3 for Nutsert install process.


New 9th hole will NOT get a Nutsert, it will use a standard nut.



In order to proceed, make sure that all the 5 holes (shown red) on each side of the vehicle are drilled, Use the 10mm (3/8") drill to open up these holes for the nutserts, and the holes are properly treated for metal protection.

Clinch the Rivet-Nut (Nutsert) to the body sheet metal in the 8 locations. Make sure your hardware stack-up is exactly as shown above. Take care, and be patient to avoid body damage / stripping. **To properly use the provided tool:**

- Back the reverse nut all the way to the head of the bolt.
- Install the Nutsert onto the threads of the bit, until it stops once the washer hits the limit collar.
- Press the full Stack-up into the hole in sheet metal
- Hold the Backer-Nut in position (13mm) and firmly into the sheet metal
- Tighten The bolt-tool head (13mm) until nutsert is fully clinched

NOTE: Only 1 Flange Nut per side used with Wheel Liners X 3 Step 1

Install Flares to vehicle:

By hand - tightening the M6 bolt (3000742), M6 Lock Washer (3000136), and M6 Flat washer (3000288) with the M6 Nut (3001569) on the backside of the body sheet metal.

NOTE: if you are installing with the Bestop Aluminum Fender well Liners (4996301) you will be installing directly into the Rivetnut that are on that assembly. You will NOT use the nut in these 2 of these 3 locations.

DO NOT TIGHTEN WITH TOOLS YET.

You will need to have the fenders loose incase of needed adjustment.



Continue to install Flares to vehicle: By hand - tightening the M6 bolt (3000742), M6 Lock Washer (3000136), and M6 Flat washer (3000288).

Torque all hardware to 8 in/lb. (10.5 Nm)
