Installation Instructions



CHEVY Silverado/GMC Sierra 1999-2007 Classic Body Style GMPAK1

*Requires a 13mm wrench and a ¼″ drill bit NOT INCLUDED

Please read all instructions before beginning the installation process. Install videos available at <u>DualLiner.com/dualliner-videos</u>

While temperature does not affect your DualLiner, it is easier to install when the bedliner is above 50 degrees Fahrenheit. If working in colder temperatures, it is helpful to warm the bedliner indoors prior to installation. The mat may take a "set" while rolled. If possible, unroll the mat and let it "relax" in the sun to make it easier to work with. If installing in cold weather it may take several weeks for the mat to fully relax.

Step 1: Install the loadguard panel. (Fig. 1)

- Position the bottom of the panel behind the forward tie downs.
- Place over the front rail and snap in place.

Step 2: Install the sidewall panels. (Fig. 2)

- Tuck the sidewall panel under the side starting at the back.
- Tuck the ends of the sidewall under the rail cap (if applicable).
- Make sure the rear tie down protrudes through the panel before the rear edge of the wheel is pushed tight to the side.
- Continue forward pushing the side wall tight to the truck bed.
- Take the rear clip and snap into place on the top of the side panel near the tailgate end.

*Tip: There is an existing hole in the truck where the clip will snap into place. If you install it upside down, it is easier to remove should you want to put a tie down strap in.

- Align the holes in the front corner's cones using a Phillips screwdriver as an alignment tool if needed and press one pine tree pin into each hole.
- Repeat on opposite side.

Step 3: Install the ZeroSkid Rubber Floor®. (Fig. 3)

- Lift the mat into the truck and unroll with nub side down.
- Start tucking the mat into the channel from front to back.
- *Tip: It is generally easiest to tuck one side, then the other side.
- Make sure it is pulled as far forward as possible for best fit.
- The mat will "settle" into position, sometimes giving it a kick or shuffling your feet will help it find its place.

Step 4: Install the tailgate panel. (Fig. 4)

- Remove the center two latch bolts using the 13mm wrench.
- Align the panel using the bolt holes as a guide.
- Replace the bolts.

*Optional: Drill ¼" holes in the center of each slot of the panel. Lift up the panel and clear any drill chips away. Apply some of the rust preventative gel to both the holes and the pine tree pins. Insert one pin in each hole, twisting as you press in place to evenly distribute the gel. Do not over-tighten, and do not use power tools. We have also included double-sided tape, should you choose not to drill. (See insert)
