Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

INSTRUCTIONS:

A) BACKREST COVER - "40" PORTION X 2:

- 1) Remove head rest (see note)
- 2) Move seat to most forward position
- 3) Slip cover over backrest and full down firmly
- 4) Tuck flaps through crevice and attach to Velcro at back
- 5) Replace headrests (see note)

B) CUSHION COVER - "40" PORTION X 2:

- 1) Center cover on the seat
- 2) pass the front strap under seat and buckle to back flap
- 3) Pass side straps around back of seat
- 4) Buckle straps to back flap
- 5) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension

C) BACKREST COVER – CENTER "20" PORTION X 1

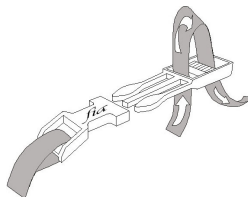
- 1) Open armrest / storage compartment
- 2) Center cover under armrest
- 3) Snug cover at back of armrest so the velcro on the cover is positioned through the crevice where lid and armrest are hinged
- 4) Position adhesive back Velcro, supplied, to align with the velcro on cover. **NOTE: BEFORE POSITIONING VELCRO, CLEAN AREA WITH ALCOHOL SWAB PROVIDED.**

D) CUSHION COVER – CENTER "20" PORTION X 1

- 1) Open cushion lid to up position
- 2) Center the cover on the seat
- 3) Tuck the back part of cushion cover through seat crevice
- 4) Pass the side straps under back corners of seat and secure to the end buckles
- 5) Adjust straps/buckles to equalize tension

NOTES:

1) SELF-LOCKING SUPER-GRIP® BUCKLE:



3) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS

- Locate headrest base and put a small slit in the stretch fabric to accommodate each of the posts
- Stretch fabric will not run
- Replace headrests

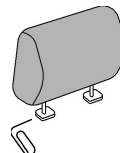
2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:

- A) - Insert paper clip into holes at base to release
- Lift off

OR

- B) - Push in side release buttons
- Lift off
