
Instructions:

Approximated installation time: 30 min.


- 1. Read and understand instructions completely before beginning installation.
- 2. Sidebar set consist of a driver and passenger side. The largest sidebar leg goes at rear of the vehicle. Be sure to determinate the correct side before installation.
- 3. Locate existing hole in the frame of the vehicle, as shown in Picture 1. Then locate the covered hole approximately 2" far from exposed hole. Picture 2. The location of the covered hole in the front of the vehicle is toward the front and in the back of the vehicle is toward the rear. *Note:* You must remove the patch that covered the hole.
- 4. Introduce the bolt guide with a 5/16 x 1 1/4" hex head bolt through the largest hole and pull out the bolt guide thru the uncovered hole. Picture 3.
- 5. Now locate the covered hole in the rocker panel. It is located in front of the two holes mentioned in the last step, see as reference the Picture 4, 5. & 8 *Note:* You must remove the patch that covered the hole.
- 6. Place 1/4" insert nut in the exposed hole on the rocker panel. Attach the insert nut to the rocket panel using the 1/4" bolt and hex nut. Hold the nut while fastening the bolt until the insert nut does not spin around into the hole. Picture 6 & 7. *Note:* Once the insert nut is attached to the frame of the vehicle, remove the 1/4" bolt and nut.
- 7. Place the mounting bracket up to the vehicle and secure to the 5/16 x 1 1/4" hex head bolt, using 5/16" flat and lock washers and hex nut. Fasten to the insert nut using 1/4 x 1" hex head bolt and flat washer. Do not tighten at this time.
- 8. Place the sidebar up to the front and rear mounting brackets and bolt to the mounting brackets using the 3/8 x 1 1/4" hex head bolts, flat and lock washers. Leave loose.
- 9. Make any final adjustments to the alignment of the sidebar and tighten all bolts. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 10. You may need to periodically re-tighten the bolts.






Front of the vehicle (passenger side)






Front of the vehicle (Passenger side)
