




Operating Your FullTilt[™] SL Tonno



on the lower hinge rail is located between the tonno frame

corner caps.

When the upper hinge rail assembly is properly centered side to side –the rail will rotate easily. Be sure that steel rail end plates are in place to keep rails from jamming.



When tonno is removed, stow the gas shock against the shock hold down stud.

Make sure that upper hinge rail assembly slides easily over ridge on lower hinge rail.

Quick Tips


• Do not overload your truck bed. Objects that press into the vinyl will wear a hole quite quickly. If you need to carry larger objects, remove the entire tonneau frame, or roll the tarp to the cab and secure. However when the tarp is rolled up the tail rail must be attached to the framework.

• If the load is too large to accommodate the tail rail, then the tonneau frame and tarp must be completely removed. Reassemble when load is removed. The tonneau can be easily stowed and reassembled for the return trip. It will improve your fuel economy all the way home!

• Do not attempt to carry the assembled tonneau loose in the truck bed, even for a short distance, and even if tied down. The tonneau will try to become airborne even at low speeds.



If you need to tow your vehicle backward, be sure to release the cover and stow against the hinge rail using Velcro® straps provided.



On a periodic basis, you should check the security of all the fasteners on your tonneau system. Trucks driven on bumpy roads or at high speeds suffer vibration that can loosen all elements of your tonneau system.

WARNING!

High winds may catch the tonno cover and cause it to open if not latched. Be very careful raising tonno in windy conditions. Cover should always be latched when down. Do not drive with cover raised or unlatched, even at slow speeds. When towing vehicle backwards, cover must be removed or tarp fully rolled and secured with Velcro® straps.

Quick and Easy Removal


Step 1- Lift and hold cover while releasing the lower joint of the gas strut.

- Step 2- Rotate the cover upward past 45° and lift out of the quick-hinge front rail system.
- Step 3- Slide off the Lower Hinge Rail.

Quick and Easy Reattachment

- Step 1- Lift cover as a unit and drop front edge into the quick-hinge front rail system groove. Be careful that locking tongue (vertical web) is between both corner pieces and Rail End Plates. There is about 1/8' total clearance on the ends. Slowly and gently rotate downward. DO NOT FORCE! IT SHOULD FALL INTO PLACE!! Note: Frame should slide side-to-side about 1/8" freely, If hinge is tight, something is wrong, you are most likely not centered.
- Step 2- Reattach the gas struts with body on bottom in open position. Drop cover and latch both sides securely.

WARRANTY DURATION:

Lifetime Frame – Extang offers a lifetime warranty against defective materials or workmanship on all tonneau rails, aluminum components, clamps, bows, hardware. **10 Year Tarp** - Extang offers a 10 year warranty against defective materials or workmanship on the vinyl covering.

WARRANTY CONDITIONS:

This warranty is against defective materials or workmanship. The warranty is void if the product has been damaged by accident, unreasonable use, neglect, improper service/installation/removal, modifications, normal wear and tear or other causes not arising out of defective materials or workmanship. Consequential and incidental damages are not covered under this warranty.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS WILL ALSO VOID THE WARRANTY:

• Wind whip damage - Tarps must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. An unsecured tarp will flap, resulting in damage to the fabric. ■ Improper cleaning - It is recommended to use the tested and approved Extang Tonno Tonic[™] or clean with soap and water only. Do not use vinyl conditioners (i.e. Armor All®) because they will shrink the vinyl.

• Overloading of cargo - Cargo should not touch the tonneau's tarp at any point. Protrusions in the tarp will stress the fabric. Cargo may shift while traveling and cause it to push against the tarp fabric and damage it.

The warranty applies to the original consumer/purchaser. Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective. Warranty coverage starts from the date of purchase.

PERFORMANCE:

Provided all warranty conditions are met Extang will either repair or replace (at Extang's option) the product or component. Extang may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Extang reserves the right to substitute and offer the respective warranty discount on an entire replacement system or provide other remedies than those listed in this warranty for discontinued products or other reasons. A return authorization number must be obtained from our customer service department prior to returning any product. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other legal rights which vary from state to state.




