



PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.





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1. Starting at the drivers side, locate the front mounting point on the rocker panel. NOTE: On some vehicles the mounting holes do not line up from the factory if this is the case drill out the holes using a 7/16" drill bit. (Fig. 1). Insert (1) M10 nut clip (Item 9) onto the small circular hole (Fig. 2) and attach (1) mounting bracket (item 3) to the nut clip using (1) M10 hex cap screw (Item 5), (1) M10 spring lock washer (Item 7), and (1) M10 flat washer (Item 6). Attach the mounting bracket to the existing holes in the pinch weld using (2) M10 hex cap screw (Item 5), (4) M10 flat washers (Item 6), (2) M10 spring lock washers (Item 7), and (2) M10 hex nuts (Item 8) (Fig. 3). Note: for 2010—up model years place (1) front mounting bracket spacer (item 11) in between the rocker panel and the front mounting bracket before attaching (Fig. 4). Do not fully tighten at this time.










- 2. Locate the second mounting point on the rocker panel (Fig. 5), insert (2) M10 clip nuts (Item 9) onto the small circular holes (Fig. 6). Attach the mounting bracket to the existing holes in the pinch weld using (2) M10 hex cap screws (Item 5), (2) M10 spring lock washers (Item 7), and (2) M10 flat washer (Item 6). Attach the mounting bracket to the existing holes in the pinch weld using (2) M10 hex cap screw (Item 5), (4) M10 flat washer (Item 6), (2) M10 spring lock washer (Item 7), and (2) M10 hex nut (Item 8). (Fig. 7) *Do not fully tighten at this time*.
- 3. Repeat this step for the rear mounting bracket. *Do not fully tighten at this time*.









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- 4. Take the drivers side step bar (Item 1) and attach it to the mounting cradles using (6) M10 button head socket cap screw (Item 10), (6) M10 internal toothed lock washer (Item 11), and (6) M10 flat washer (Item 12). (Fig. 8) Do not fully tighten at this time.
- 5. Repeat steps 2-5 for passenger side.
- 6. Align and adjust step bars as needed then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Torque all M10 fasteners to 30-35 ft lbs.
