


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS




PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Lift up the hood and locate (12) plastic push pins on the radiator cover. Remove the plastic push pins in order to remove the radiator cover. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove (4) screws that attach the grille to the vehicle. Carefully lift and pull off the grille. See **Figure 2**. **Note:** Grille is attached to vehicle with several plastic clips.









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- 4. Locate the upper brackets and secure both onto the vehicle using the provided M6 hardware: (2) M6 hex head cap screw,
 (2) M6 flat washers, and (2) M6 split lock washers (Items 6, 8, & 9). See Figure 3.
- Locate the lower brackets and secure both onto the vehicle using the provided M8 hardware: (2) M8 hex head cap screw,
 (2) M8 flat washers, and (2) M8 split lock washers (Items 10 12). See Figure 3.
- 6. Align and adjust the brackets as necessary then torque M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs and M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs.
- 7. Align the HDX LED Grille (Item 1) with the previously installed brackets and loosely secure using the provided M6 hardware (Items 7-9). See **Figure 4**.
- 8. Align and adjust the grille and brackets as necessary then torque M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs and M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs . **Note:** Refer to **Page 4** for the light wiring instructions.










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- 9. Remove top part of vehicle's factory grille by cutting it off. Cut into the factory grille honeycomb pattern. Refer to **Figures 5 and 6.**
- 10. Cut indicator pin on OE Top Grille Lip. See Figure 7 & 8.
- 11. Install the recently cut top part of the grille onto the vehicle using the same (4) factory bolts that were removed in Step 3.
- 12. Re-install the radiator cover removed in Step 2.
- 13. Align and adjust the grille and brackets as necessary then torque hardware: M6 5-7 ft-lbs, M8 15-18 ft-lbs.
 - Note: Brackets can be bent in order to adjust and align in order to achieve desired fit.









CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.




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WIRING INSTRUCTIONS (CAUTION):

- 1. Disconnect ground connection from battery (-) to avoid accidental short circuits before attempting to connect electrical wires.
- 2. When running wires, avoid areas of excessive heat, vibration, pinch or rotation when securing harness to vehicle.
- 3. Always use a fused (+) positive supply source.
- 4. This light becomes hot under continuous use. Do not remove or touch the casting for at least 30 minutes after the lamp has been turned off.

WESTIN recommends using a professional for this installation. Refer to Figure 9 below.

- 1. Locate the wiring harness and mount the switch in a convenient location where it is easily accessible from the drivers seat. **Note:** *The switch will need to be removed from the wiring harness so that the rest of the harness can be routed from the engine bay to the cabin.*
- 2. Route the wiring harness wire, specifically the fuse and relay, from the positive battery terminal along the firewalls existing wire routes. **Note:** *Tape as necessary to correct slack*.
- 3. Secure the relay by either drilling or using a pre-existing bolt along the chassis that is not connected to any other wire.
- 4. Run the switch harness through the firewall preferably through the pre-existing rubber plug that is used to run the OEM wiring harness from the engine bay to fuse box. **Note:** *Reconnect the switch to the wiring harness*.
- 5. Place the LED plug wire along the fender chassis where it will not get pinched and away from any moving parts (fan, pulleys etc.).
- 6. Run the attached wire from the LED Light Bar as previously mentioned away from any moving parts.
- 7. Connect both ends of wiring connectors from LED light bar and wiring harness.
- 8. Re-connect battery terminals, attach the red (+) wire to battery positive, and the black (-) wire to ground. Note: *A dd dielec-tric grease (not supplied)*.
- 9. Turn on the switch to make sure if the light works. If not, please check carefully if the wiring installation is correct.

DRILLING:

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle. FAILURE TO REVIEW AN AREA TO BE DRILLED MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR INJURY TO OTHERS AS WELL AS VEHICLE DAMAGE.

EYE PROTECTION:

ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES OR GOGGLES DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS TO AVOID PERSONAL INJURY.

MAXIMUM TOWING/CARRYING CAPACITY:

The Westin Receiver Hitches will have a visible tow rating label affixed directly on the product. User should never exceed the vehicle manufacturers maximum tow and weight rating regardless of the capacity of the hitch.
