




### PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


- 2. Start by lifting up the hood and remove the radiator cover by removing the plastic push pins. See **Figure 1.**
- 3. Under the radiator cover remove screws that attach the grille. Refer to Figure 2.
- 4. Carefully pull off the grille making sure to unplug any electrical wires. See **Figure 3.**
- 5. The plastic skeleton is the part that the grille was bolted to. Remove all bolts that attach the plastic skeleton to the vehicle. Loosen the headlights and push them outwards by removing bolts that attach it to the vehicle. Refer to **Figures 4 7.**
- 6. Remove horn from the plastic skeleton. See **Figure 10.**
- 7. Once horn is removed from the plastic skeleton, it can be removed from the vehicle. See **Figure 8**. (**Note:** If plastic skeleton cannot be removed after loosening headlights and pushing them outward, remove headlights from the vehicle by removing the bolt that attaches it to the fender. Unplug headlight bulbs from wiring harness. See **Figure 9**.





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











Remove the plastic skeleton shown below from












- 8. Reattach the vehicle's horn onto the vehicle's radiator on the passenger side using the factory hardware. See **Figure 11 & 12.** (**Note:** May need to bend bracket in order to make horn fit properly.)
- 9. Locate (2) Upper Bracket A (Items 2 & 3) and (2) Upper Bracket B (Items 4 & 5). Loosely secure the upper brackets onto the vehicle using the previously removed factory hardware. Refer to **Figure 13.**




- 10. Locate (2) Mount Bracket A (Items 6 & 7) and (2) Mount Bracket B (Items 8 & 9). Use the provided M8 hardware (Items 10 12) to loosely secure onto vehicle. Refer to **Figure 13.**
- 11. Align the HDX LED Grille (Item 1) with the previously installed brackets and loosely secure using the provided M6 hardware (Items 13 15). Refer to **Figure 14.**
- 12. Align and adjust the grille and brackets as necessary then torque hardware: M8 to 15-18 ft-lbs and M6 5-7 ft-lbs. **Note:** Brackets can be bent in order to adjust and align in order to achieve desired fit.





## Care Instructions

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.




### WIRING INSTRUCTIONS (CAUTION):


- 1. Disconnect ground connection from battery (-) to avoid accidental short circuits before attempting to connect electrical wires.
- 2. When running wires, avoid areas of excessive heat, vibration, pinch or rotation when securing harness to vehicle.
- 3. Always use a fused (+) positive supply source.
- 4. This light becomes hot under continuous use. Do not remove or touch the casting for at least 30 minutes after the lamp has been turned off.

### WESTIN recommends using a professional for this installation. Refer to Figure 6 below.

- 1. Locate the wiring harness and mount the switch in a convenient location where it is easily accessible from the drivers seat.

  Note: The switch will need to be removed from the wiring harness so that the rest of the harness can be routed from the engine bay to the cabin.
- 2. Route the wiring harness wire, specifically the fuse and relay, from the positive battery terminal along the firewalls existing wire routes. **Note:** *Tape as necessary to correct slack*.
- 3. Secure the relay by either drilling or using a pre-existing bolt along the chassis that is not connected to any other wire.
- 4. Run the switch harness through the firewall preferably through the pre-existing rubber plug that is used to run the OEM wiring harness from the engine bay to fuse box. **Note:** *Reconnect the switch to the wiring harness*.
- 5. Place the LED plug wire along the fender chassis where it will not get pinched and away from any moving parts (fan, pulleys etc.).
- 6. Run the attached wire from the LED Light Bar as previously mentioned away from any moving parts.
- 7. Connect both ends of wiring connectors from LED light bar and wiring harness.
- 8. Re-connect battery terminals, attach the red (+) wire to battery positive, and the black (-) wire to ground. **Note:** *Add dielectric grease (not supplied)*.
- 9. Turn on the switch to make sure if the light works. If not, please check carefully if the wiring installation is correct.

## **FASTENERS:**

All Westin supplied fasteners must be utilized and installed in accordance with the installation instructions and apply torque to the specifications as defined. DOUBLE CHECK ALL FASTENERS BEFORE INITIAL USE, AND PERIODICALLY IN THE FUTURE TO ENSURE PROPER FUNCTION AND SAFETY.

## **DRILLING:**

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle. FAILURE TO REVIEW AN AREA TO BE DRILLED MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR INJURY TO OTHERS AS WELL AS VEHICLE DAMAGE.

## **EYE PROTECTION:**

ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES OR GOGGLES DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS TO AVOID PERSONAL INJURY.

### **MAXIMUM TOWING/CARRYING CAPACITY:**
